Ginny also trains and supports Crossroads' volunteers through the Community Chaplain Program. Community Chaplain training discusses several crises a chaplain may encounter in their every day walk including: financial crises, evangelism, marriage and divorce, substance abuse, grief and suicide. These trained volunteers designate an area of their lives as their ministry and come alongside people, encouraging them, helping them, and pointing them toward Christ.
