



Lesson Overview:

This Sunday we continue our series on Identity. In this series we are looking at the fundamental fact that all our identity needs to be found in Christ first. Only when our core identity is found in Christ can we live, influence, and love those around us. This week's message titled "Who Am I?" focuses on understanding who we are in Christ. We will discuss how this foundational understanding causes us to grow and become who Christ called and created us to be. Only through knowing who we are in Christ can we stand for what is right and face the pressure to conform and bend our values to what others are saying.

Lesson Prep for Leaders:

Main Bible Passage: Luke 12:16-21, Romans 8:17, Ephesians 2:10, Jeremiah 29:11

Questions for Leaders to ask yourself:

- Who does God say you are? How does he describe you? How does this knowledge change you?
- How can living in our identity found in Christ impact how we interact with the people in our lives?
- When we misplace our identity what are the implications for us and others?



Icebreaker (5 Min): How is school going so far? What happened this week?

Students Lead (5 Min): How can we discover where our identity is found?

Discussion Questions (10 Min):

- Who does Jesus say you are? How does or can this impact your daily life?
- Why do people settle for a false identity? Why do you think people look to things, titles, or other people for their identity?
- How does the place, thing, or truth we find our identity in effect you? How can we find our identity more in Christ this week?

Next Steps (2 Min): Come up with a list as a group of what our identity in Christ is. Share this with your group so every student can take it home with them and look at it every day this week.

Prayer (2 Min): Close your time in Prayer
