

Serve Opportunities at Millbrook Campus

Adult Classes

Class Administrator – perform administrative duties for Sunday mornings or Wednesday night instructional classes

Class Table Discussion Leader – arrive at class a little early, welcome people to their table and facilitate a table discussion using questions provided

Financial Freedom Mentor – assist individuals/couples with preparing a Financial Freedom Plan

Behind the Scenes

Safety and Emergency Response Team – ensure a safe and secure worship environment by responding to and coordinating requests for medical assistance

Library – assist individuals wanting to check out books from the library Sunday mornings or Wednesday nights

Care Ministries

Abilities Enabled – support families and caregivers of children, teens and adults with special needs

Celebration Station – work with school-aged children of parents in Celebrate Recovery through activities, games, music and play

Crisis Care Response Team – help to meet physical needs of unconnected members/attenders dealing with a life changing event

Divorce Care for Kids (DC4K) Encourager – work with school-aged children of divorced parents through activities, games, music and play

Extended Care – once per month check in on a person with long care needs

GriefShare – grief recovery support with special groups for suicide survivors, parents who've lost children, widows/widowers and others

Marriage/Pre-Marriage Mentoring – become a marriage or pre-marriage mentor

Guest Services

External Door Greeter – provide a warm greeting and sense of belonging to each individual entering the building; looking for people with a warm smile, firm handshake and a genuine love for others

Invitation Counselor – minister to people who have opened their hearts to God's word & the Holy Spirit

Usher – provide worshippers with a warm greeting, a bulletin, and help in finding a seat along with assisting in taking the offering and serving communion at any worship service; looking for people who enjoy people and have a servant's heart

Welcome Center Assistant – provide current information on the ministries and programs of the church to those seeking to connect, grow and serve at Crossroads and the community in a helpful and friendly way

Parking Greeter – greet folks in the parking lot before services

Kids Ministry

Nursery Caregiver – hold babies or follow waddlers around in the nursery

Preschool Helper – help preschoolers learn through play and activities

Elementary Small Group Leader – assist in an elementary class, the grade of your choosing

Sunday Morning Welcome Desk Assistant – assist new families through registration, hand out welcome packets and provide directions

Wednesday Night Greeter – staff the kids welcome desk to greet, register and direct newcomers to the proper classroom

Awana Group Guide – guide small groups of 5-7 preschool or elementary-aged children, listening to children recite Bible verses they have memorized (no preparation needed)

Abilities Enabled Support – help in one of our special needs classrooms or work one on one with a child with special needs in a classroom (no special skills required, training provided)

Missions Outreach

Missions Thrift Store – sort and process donated items or work in the store on sale days at the thrift store located at our Millbrook Campus

Café Ministry – assist on Sunday mornings with set-up, clean-up, cashiering and restocking supplies

Food Drives – assist with our church-wide food drives held in the spring, summer and fall by preparing and passing out the bags and collecting the donations

Helping Hands – minister to those who cannot make necessary household repairs due to financial or physical limitations (carpentry, electrical, plumbing and painting skills needed)

Prayer Ministry

Prayer Intercessor – pray for one hour each week using online prayer requests, can use Prayer Room if desired or pray at home

Prayer Group Member – pray before worship services and classes

Small Groups

Small Group Leader - organize and facilitate a group of people to connect, grow, serve, pray and give as you pursue God's plan together; can meet almost anywhere and designed by the leader to reflect his/her passions and gifts

Small Group Host – provide your home as a meeting place for a small group that needs a venue. Hosts become part of the small group that meets in their home

Students Ministry

Welcome Team - welcome new students and their families to help get them plugged in

Middle School Small Group Leader – serve in a middle school worship service Sunday mornings, enjoying the day's activities with them and leading them in a table discussion around the current topic

High School Small Group Leader – lead a discussion around the current topic during a Sunday morning class or offsite group during the week

Sound & Tech Team – assist students with audio set up, sound mix and sound check for the middle or high school services

Worship Team – mentor the next generation of middle or high school worship leaders

Security Team – ensure students are in their designated places during Sunday morning and Wednesday night services

Special Events – facilitate special events (United, Slopfest, Camp)

Women's Ministry

Group Leader (Women) – facilitate growth in the Lord, fellowship, service and a safe place for women to connect who desire to become fully devoted followers of Jesus in a small group

Group Host (Women) - use your gift of hospitality to assist a Group Leader to help women become fully devoted followers of Jesus in your home

Group Leader (Girls 6th-12th grade) - Sun AM or Wed PM on campus, or off campus, use your gifts and talents to lead a small group; looking for women committed to being a consistent and encouraging presence in the lives of these girls

Group Host (Girls 6th-12th grade) – use your gift of hospitality and passion to serve by hosting a small group in your home

Special Events (Girls 6th-12th grade) - sign up for event notification and serve as your schedule allows

Worship, Tech & Creative Arts

Worship Team – rehearse and lead the music once a month as a singer or musician in our weekly worship services

Audio Tech Team – complete audio set up, sound mix, sound checks, and all aspects of audio for services and other special events (training provided)

Media Team – oversee lyrics displayed on the screens using ProPresenter during musical worship, switching to other multimedia being used when needed (training provided)

Video Project Production Team – produce video clips and DVDs used in the services, such as special video announcements

Camera Operator – assist in capturing the Sunday morning services and other special events via video (training provided)

Drama Team – act, write scripts or build sets for use as sermon illustrations and special holiday events

Young Adults Ministry

Greeting Team – welcome our Crossroads family at the Hargrove entrance, hold the door and simply say, “Good morning!”

Parking Team – direct incoming traffic and parking for newcomers at the Millbrook entrance

Sunday Morning Connect – greet, set up monthly lunches, be a table leader, take attendance

UNITE Team – greet, set up crew, tear down crew, help with planning

Worship Team/Music – use your musical talents to lead others to worship at Unite worship nights and spring and fall retreats
