

**Lesson Overview:**

This week we will continue our new series “Servolution” with the sermon “Team player”. This week will be looking at our roles on Christ’s team. We will focus on the foundational truth needed in every role that someone can have in serving Christ. We will look at John 13:1-17 and see that in each role the foundation needs to be a servant’s heart and that true leaders serve. We need to understand that no one role is more important and no one person is more valuable, rather we all have a part to play in serving God.

**Lesson Prep for Leaders:**

Main Bible Passage: John 13:1-17

**Questions to ask yourself:**

- What does this story teach you about serving others?
- When Jesus washed his disciples’ feet, how was this a humbling experience for him? What message was he teaching his disciples?
- What is the blessing Jesus is speaking about in the final verse?



**Icebreaker** (5 Min): Who is excited about March madness? Who is filling out a bracket?

**Students Lead** (5 Min): Talk about people who have influenced you the most? Why have they had this influence?

**Discussion Questions** (10 Min):

- What lesson was Jesus teaching his disciples in the story shared today?
- How can we implement this lesson into our everyday life? What mindsets do we need to change to be passionate with serving others?
- What do you think was going through Peter's mind during his conversation with Jesus?

**Next Steps** (2 Min): Make a plan as a small group to serve together next Sunday before or after service to make others feel welcomed at Crossroads Students.
