



In our new series “Bigger Faith” we take a look at how each student grows in their faith. This week we continue our conversation with “Walls of Jericho”. The people received a bizarre call from God that called for bigger faith. Sometimes God asks us to do something that (to us) doesn’t make a lot of sense. But he knows what he is doing and he is simply asking us to trust him and have active faith in him.

Lesson Prep for Leaders:

Main Bible Passages: Hebrews 11:30

Prep Questions:

- How is victory found in faith?
- What power is found in acting in faith even when we think our portion is insignificant to true victory?
- What steps in your life have you taken to “play your part”?



Special Note: Lists are fun - Today we will try to think of practical asks God may make of us and how we would respond to those asks. Learning to say yes to the small asks allows us to say yes to the big.

Breakout Discussion (20 Min):

- Write a list things God has or could ask you to do. Think about practical things he would ask at school, home, and with friends.
- Once the list is completed ask: How would you respond if God asked you to do this?
- How can saying yes to the small asks of God prepare us to say yes when a big ask comes our way?

Next Steps (5 Min): Discuss the victory we can experience when we say yes to God in the situations you listed above.
