Lesson Prep for Leaders:

Main Bible Passages: Hebrews 11:13-16

Prep Questions:

- How do we make an abstract concept like an eternal home real to students this week?
- What helps connect the hope of a future home to help us through our current struggles?
- What mindset do you see revealed in these verses? How do we develop this mindset in ourselves?



Special Note: Discussion time this week for breakouts. Take time to get to know new 6th grader's and ensure they are connecting to other students in the ministry.

Breakout Discussion (20 Min):

- Why do you think Hebrews says God is "not ashamed to be called their God"?
- What does having bigger faith prepare us for?
- What do you think the benefits of God "not being ashamed" are in your present life? What hope do we have in Christ? How does this hope impact us today?
- How do you hope God uses you this week, month, and year? What impact do you want to have?

Next Steps (5 Min): Have the students write down a personal hope they have in putting their faith in God.
