**Lesson Prep for Leaders:**

Main Bible Passages: Hebrews 11:8-10; 17-19

Prep Questions:

- What has been your biggest obstacle to overcome when it comes to having faith in God?
- What does Abraham’s story teach us about faith and how living our lives by faith impacts our destination?
- How can you connect your breakout this week to Abraham’s faith life and journey?



**Special Note: This week we will have a time of discussion around Abraham's life of faith and how these idea's are practical to us today. Take time to help new students get into breakouts.**

**Breakout Discussion (20 Min):**

- Review the steps of faith Abraham took in Hebrews. Why do you think he was able to take each subsequent step in his obedience to God?
- What do you think was going through Abraham's mind when God made these asks of him? What would you be thinking? Why do you think Abraham still acted on faith in each situation?
- How does stepping out in faith grow your faith more? Does anyone have an example of a time they stepped out in faith to follow God?
