



In our new series “Bigger Faith” we take a look at how each student grows in their faith. This week we continue our conversation with “An Expressive Faith”. Faith expresses itself. It works itself out. It’s visible and evident to ourselves and the people in our lives. It works itself out through love. Faith isn’t something that shows itself through what we can do (or accomplish). It expresses itself through love (from God, for God and for others)

Lesson Prep for Leaders:

Main Bible Passages: Galatians 5:6

Prep Questions:

- How is faith expressed through love in your life?
- How do we lead with love as we serve and interact with others?
- How can you lead students to exercise their faith this week?



Special Note: This week we will push serving in student ministry and *attend 1 & serve 1* service each week. There will be sign up cards with special opportunities for HS juniors and seniors to sign up to help co-lead breakouts.

Breakout discussion (20 Min):

- Why do you think faith is expressed through love? What does this look like?
- Describe a person in your life who you have seen express their faith through love. How have they impacted your life?
- What can you learn from these examples, what will you do with what you see and learn?

Next Steps (5 Min): Take a few minutes at the end to talk about the different serve options on the card and have students who are not currently serving sign up to serve if interested.
